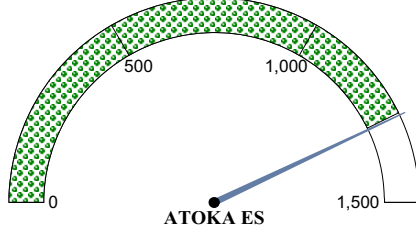

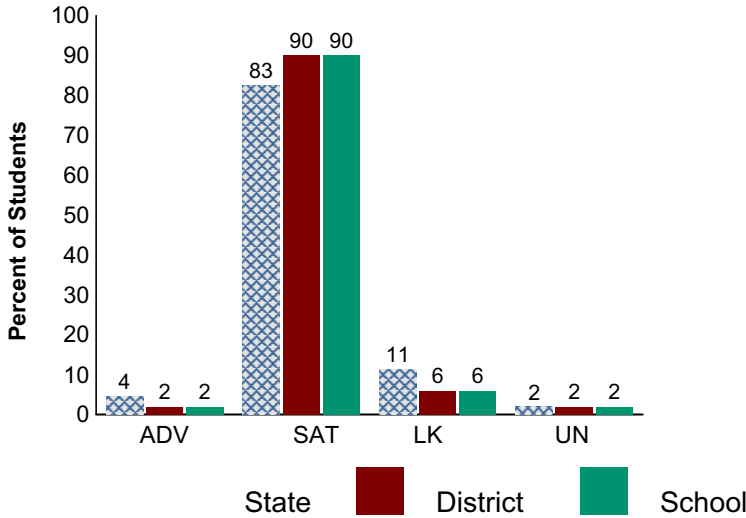

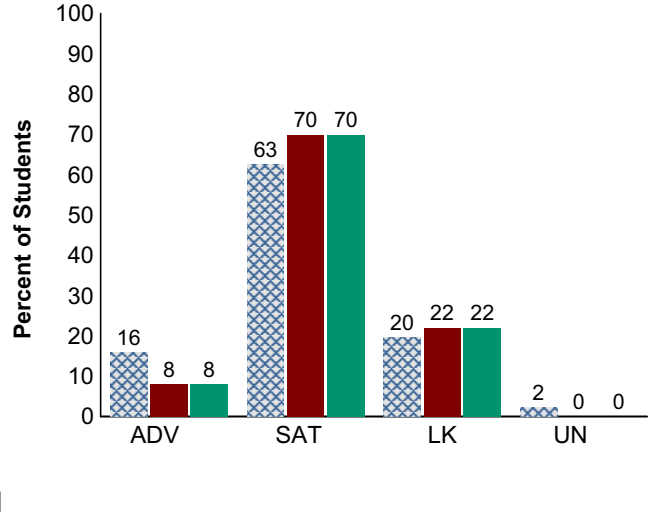
State, District, and School Reading Results

All Students Tested



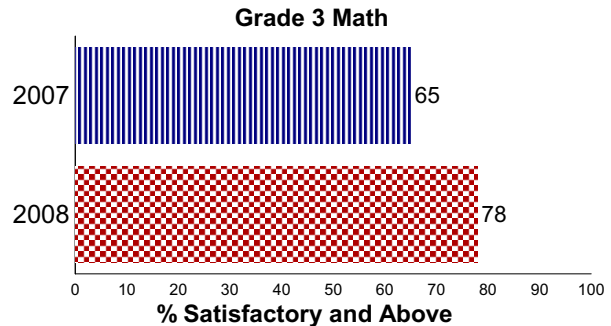
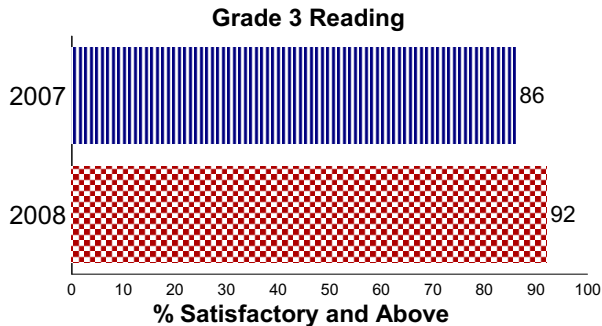
State, District, and School Math Results

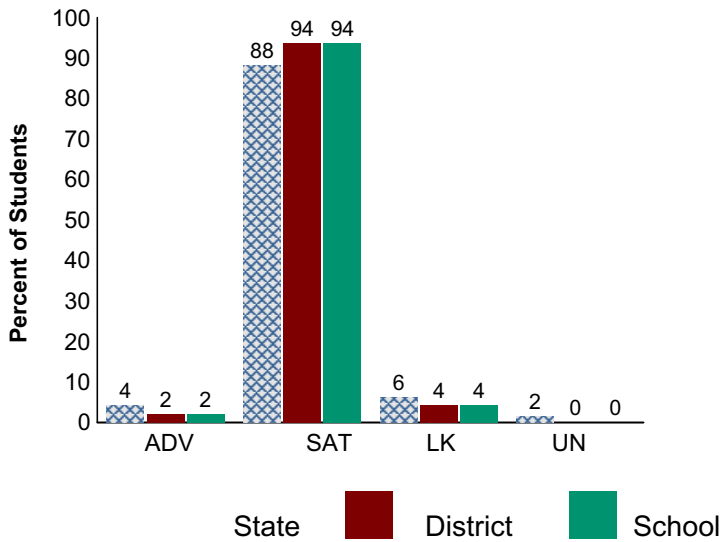

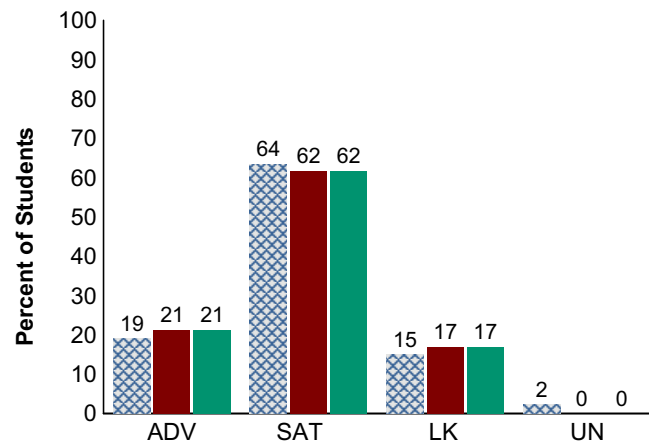
State, District, and School Reading Results

State, District, and School Math Results

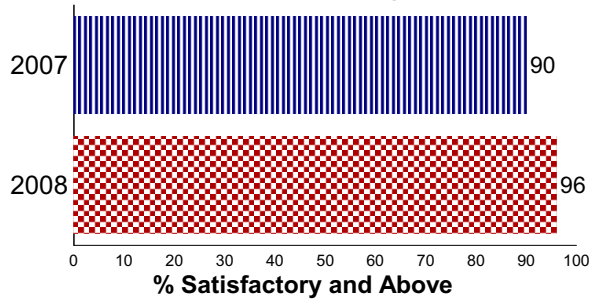

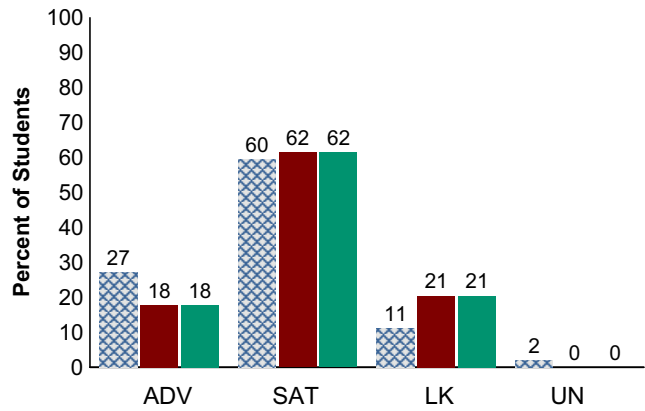
State, District, and School Reading Results

State, District, and School Math Results

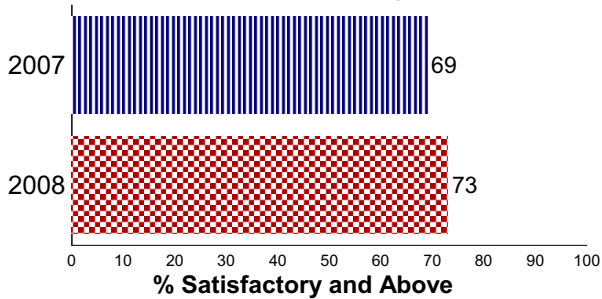

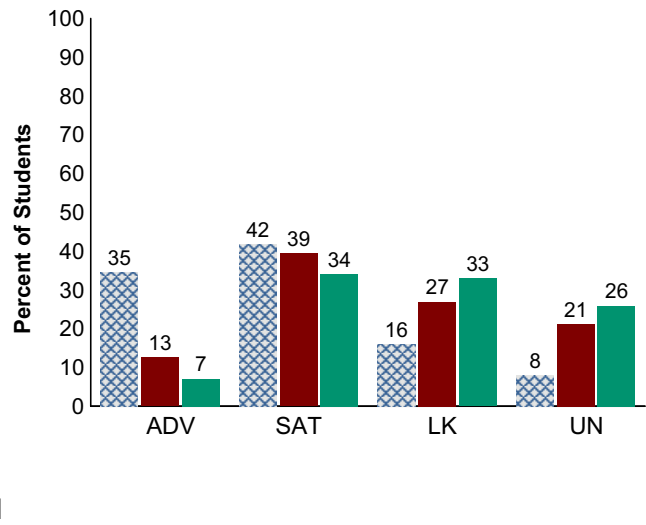
State, District, and School Reading Results

State, District, and School Math Results

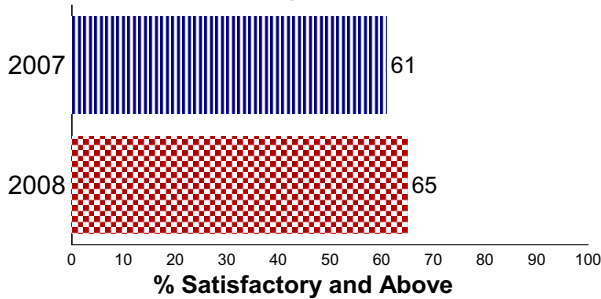

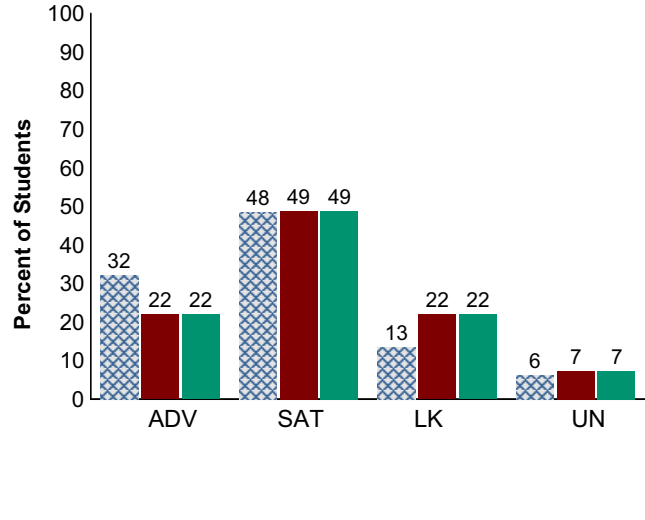
State, District, and School Reading Results

State, District, and School Math Results

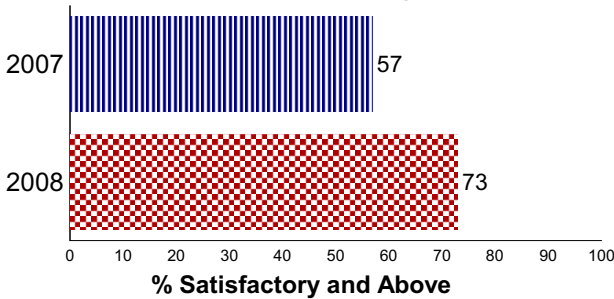

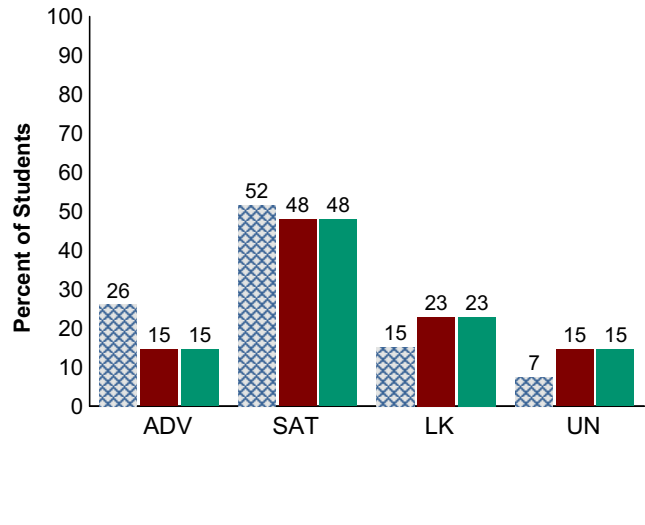
State, District, and School Reading Results

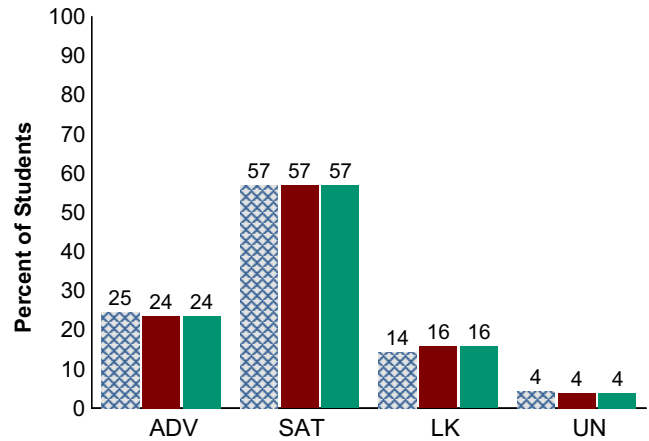
State, District, and School Reading Results

All Students Tested



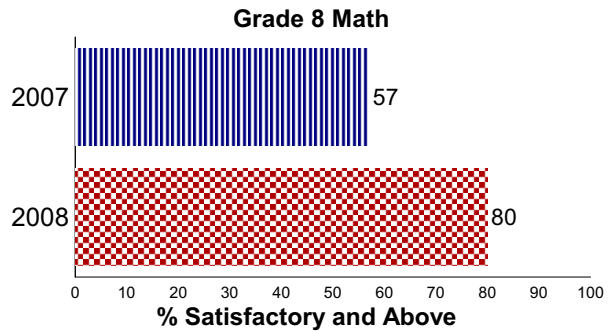
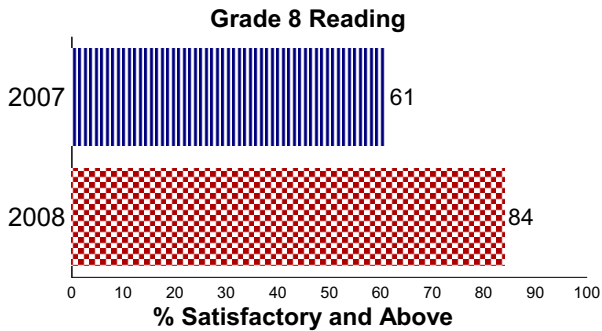
